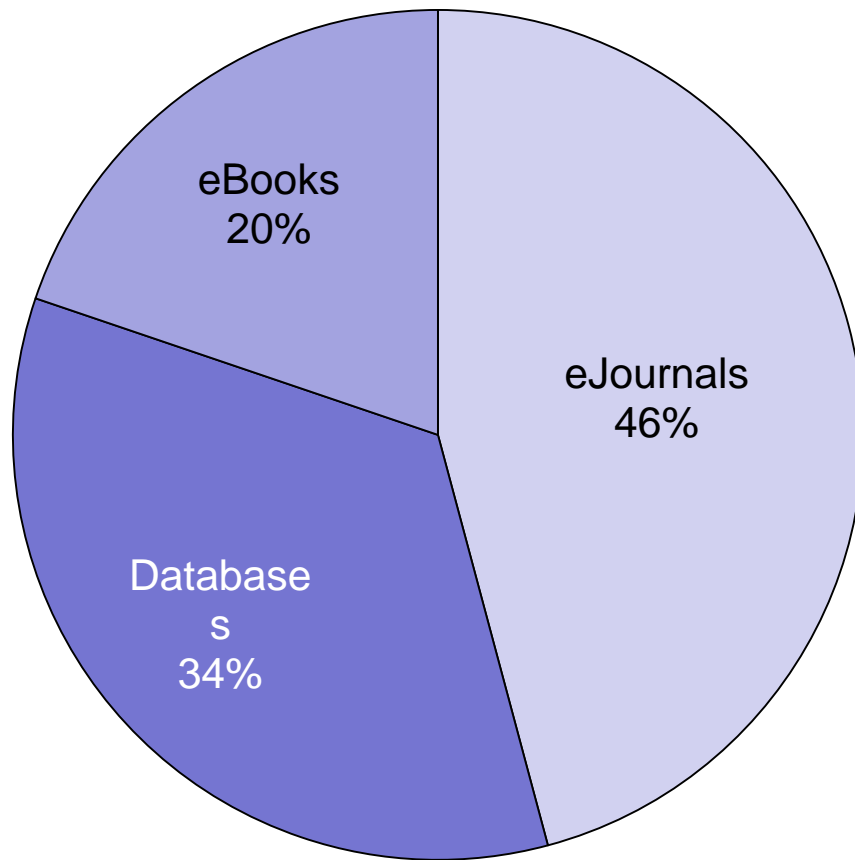

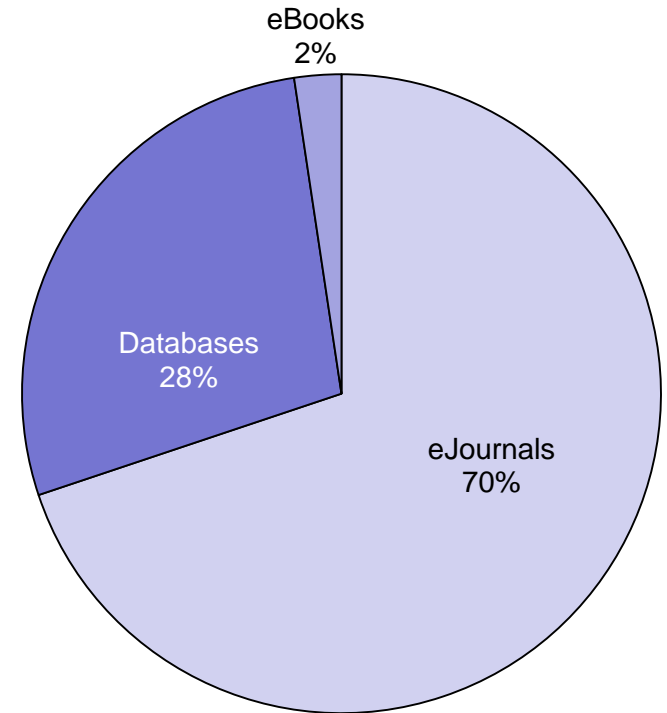

## National Licenses survey 2013



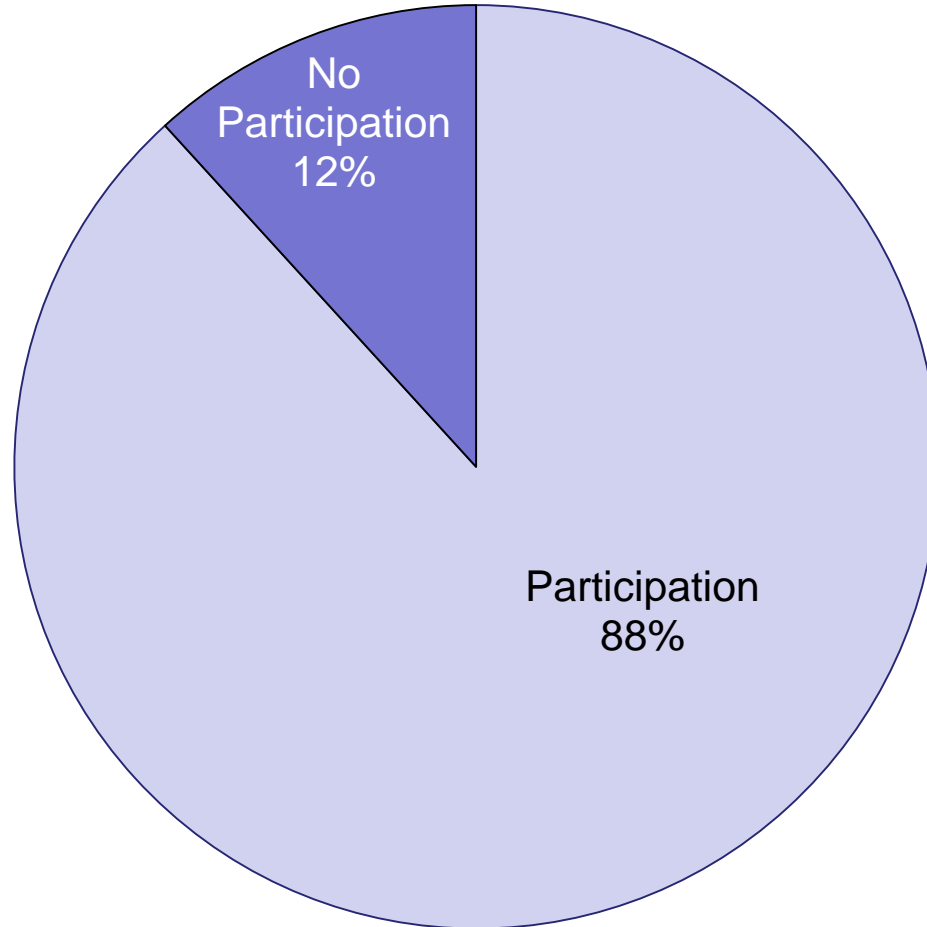
## CSAL expenditures 2012

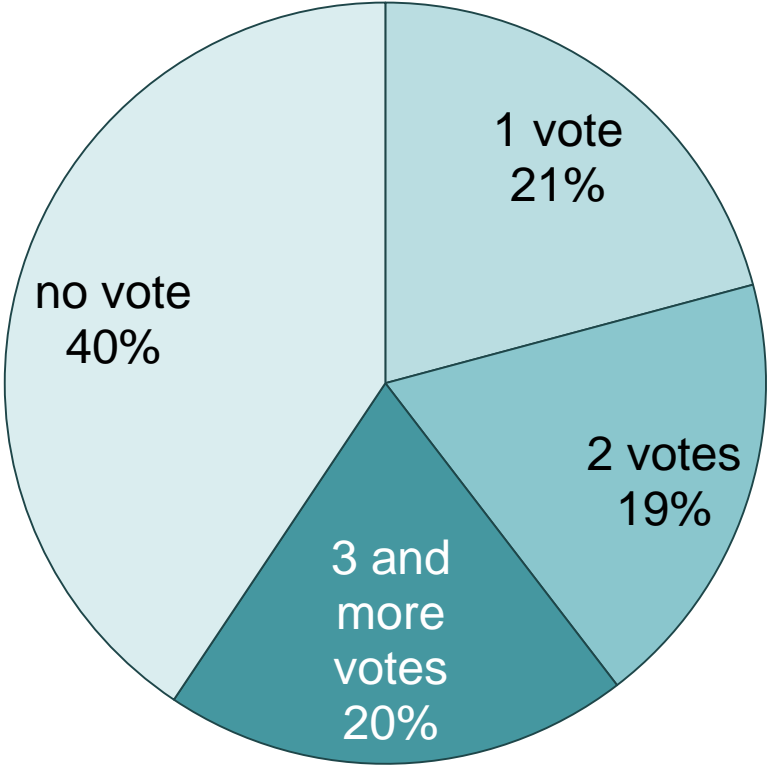

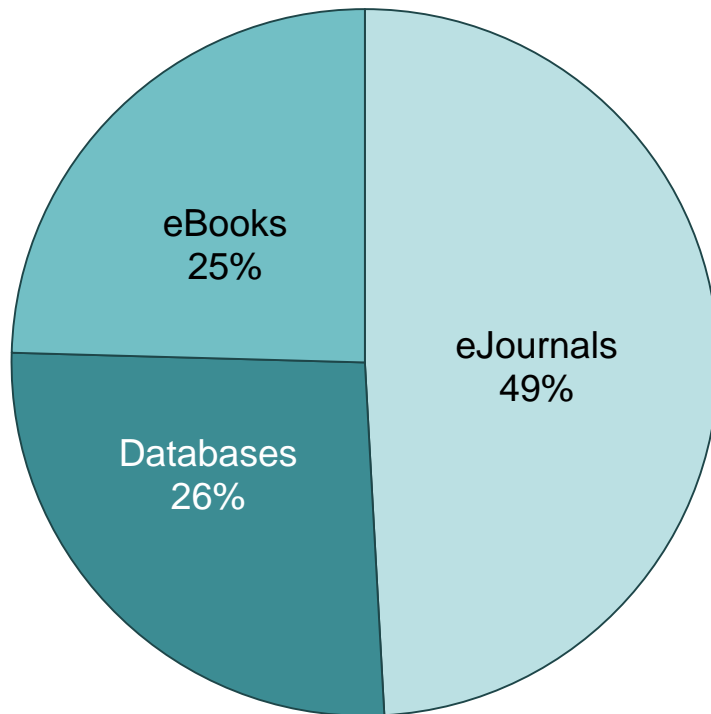

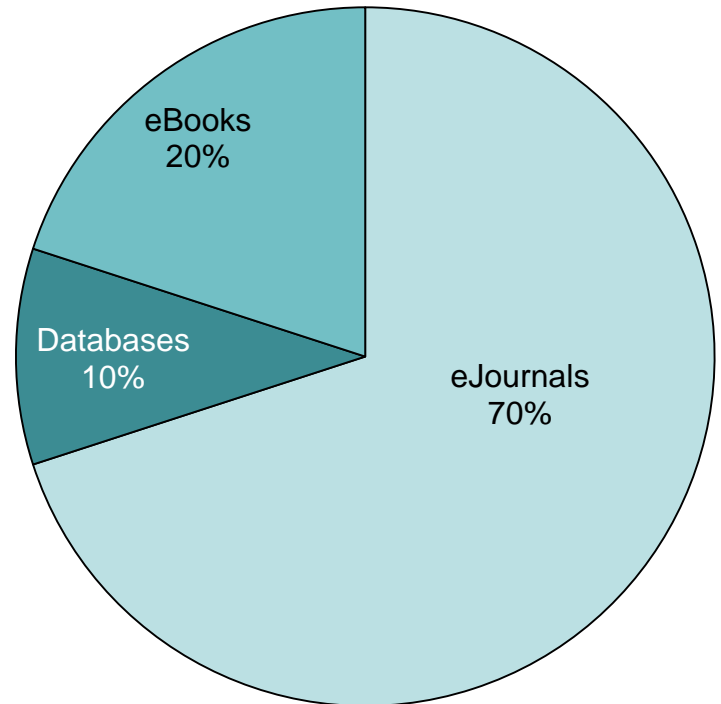




## Products with at least 1 vote
